



GARLAND COWL

Garland Cowl was designed with my “beautiful daughter” in mind. Her special present! This cowl has a wonderful drape. It is long enough to be worn long or twisted & looped.

Mom

- Yarn :** Approximately 200 yards of aran or worsted weight yarn (Fiber or fiber mix that offers drape is recommended)
- Needles:** US size 10.5 (6.5mm) 29 inch circular
- Gauge:** 4 – 4.5 stitches per inch using garter
- Size:** 7.5” wide / 60” long (blocked) – Note: Blocking is essential
To lenthen or shorten cowl you will want to increase/decrease by multiples of 14 to stay in pattern.
- Notions:** Darning needle, optional row counter

Pattern Notes

**Stretchy cast on and bind off is recommended.

I used Jeny’s stretch cast on – two needle method. Here is link to helpful video

**Cowl is knit in the round and there is no seaming required.

**Be sure and block your cowl. Blocking shows off the wonderful lacy pattern!

Abbreviations

St(s) – Stitch

K – knit

P – purl

YO – yarn over

K2tog – Knit 2 sts together

SL – Slip stitch

SSK – Slip, slip, knit

K2tog – Knit 2 stitches together

PSSO – Pass slip stitch over

RS – right side

WS – wrong side

PATTERN

Cast on 126 sts. Join in the round taking care not to twist your stitches.

Round 1 – Knit

Round 2 – Purl

Round 3 – Knit

Round 4 – Purl

Round 5 – Knit

Round 6 – (YO, K2tog) repeat around

Round 7 – Knit

Round 8 – Purl

Round 9 – Knit

Round 10 - 14 (YO, K2tog) repeat around

Round 15 – Knit

Round 16 – Purl

Round 17 – 19 Knit

Round 20 – Purl

Round 21 – Knit

Round 22 – Purl

Round 23 – [K1, k2tog, yo, k1, yo, ssk, k1] repeat around

Round 24 – [K2tog, yo, k3, yo, ssk] repeat around

Round 25 – [K1, yo, k2tog, yo, sl1, k2tog, pssso, yo, k1] repeat around

Round 26 – [K1, yo, ssk, k1, k2tog, yo, k1] repeat around

Round 27 – [K2, yo, sl1, k2tog, pssso, yo, k2] repeat around

Round 28 – Purl
Round 29 – Knit
Round 30 – Purl
Round 31 – 33 Knit
Round 34 – Purl
Round 35 – Knit
Round 36 – 40 (YO, k2tog) repeat around
Round 41 – Knit
Round 42 – Purl
Round 43 – Knit
Round 44 – (YO, k2tog) repeat around
Round 45 – Knit
Round 46 – Purl
Round 47 – Knit
Round 48 – Purl
Round 49 – Knit

Bind off using a stretchy bind-off method. Block and Enjoy!
